- 8. Tell me about a mistake you've made. (Be sure to explain what you learned from this mistake)

- 10. What has been your most rewarding experience working with others?
- 11. What do you think is the most pressing issue in healthcare today?
- 12. Would your plans to become a physician change if the U.S. moved to a universal healthcare system, similar to Canada?
- 13. How do you think the U.S. should address the physician shortage problem, particularly in primary care doctors in rural areas?
- 14. What is the difference between Medicare and Medicaid?
- 15. Why did you choose your major? How has it prepared you for a career in medicine?
- 16. What was your favorite class and why?
- 17. Discuss a book that you've recently read for pleasure. Why did this book interest you?
- 18. How do you spend your free time?
- 19. What do you consider to be your strengths and your shortcomings?
- 20. There are 1,000 applicants as qualified as you, why should we select you for our class?
- 21. Do you have specific goals in medicine? Where do you see yourself in 5-10 years?
- 22. What will you do if you don't get into medical school?
- 23. Do you have any questions for us?
