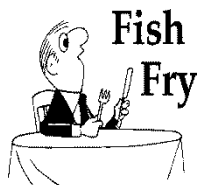

A Plenary Indulgence

Remember, attending Mass on **March 19, the Feast of St. Joseph**, may gain you a Plenary Indulgence due to our "**spiritual bond**" with the **Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome**. Because of this "spiritual bond", a Plenary Indulgence will be granted if certain conditions are followed. **These conditions are** (to be performed 8 days before or after the visit):

1. Sacramental confession
2. Eucharistic communion
3. Prayers for the intention of the Holy Father
4. The repudiation of all forms of sin
5. Participation in liturgical celebrations and recitation of the Lord's Prayer and the Creed (on March 19th).
