

Periodontal Chart (perio residents/faculty)

Open a patient's periodontal chart

1. Select the patient in the Rolodex
2. Click the periodontal chart icon *OR*
3. Click the E.H.R. icon, then click the *Perio* tab

Create a new perio chart or resume an incomplete chart

1. Click the *Add New* button
2. If you have entered incomplete perio charts, a prompt will open to confirm whether you want to resume the incomplete exam.
3. To resume an incomplete exam, click *Yes* at the prompt. A list of incomplete exams will open
4. Select the exam to complete and click *OK*

Chart Perio Conditions

1. Position your cursor in the first value you want to enter
2. Use either the mouse or the keyboard to enter the value
3. Click *Next*, *Up*, *Down* or *Prev* to move to the next location
4. Click the arrow keys next to the quadrant location to navigate quadrants
5. To clear all values for a site, click in the site, then click *Clear Tooth*
6. To clear one value for a site, click the value, then click *Clear*
7. When you have finished charting, click *Incomplete* or *Complete*

Perio Chart Buttons/Icons



Add new
Create a new perio chart



History
Lists history of perio charts



Full View
Shows full-screen view of conditions (text) or sites (graphics)



Compare
Opens the Comparison screen, from which you can select a perio condition and dates for comparison



Perio icon
Opens the selected patient's periodontal chart from the axiUm desktop
