VETERANS AID AND ATTENDANCE

- The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) awards a special monthly pension benefit called **Aid & Attendance** to wartime veterans and surviving spouses of deceased wartime veterans.
- This "extra" pension is available to wartime veterans and spouses who live in nursing homes or <u>assisted living facilities</u>.
- Maximum awards for veterans can reach approximately \$1758/month, couples \$2085/month, and surviving spouses can receive up to \$1130/month.
