*Spaces, hyphens, and spelling can impact the ability to access the record. Be sure to type name exactly as it appears on the visa including these additional characters and spaces.

* If unable to access the I-94 using your name as it appears on the visa, enter your name as it appears on the bottom of your passport in the Machine Readable Zone below your photo. If still unable to access the I-94, enter your name as it appears on your plane ticket.

*If your passport number is more than 10 characters, enter only the last 10 characters.

*Passport number may contain numbers and letters. Be sure to distinguish between the two. Common errors: Number zero (0) and letter O and the number one (1) and letter I.

* Still unable to access record? You may need assistance from Customs and Border Protection.
