

DS-5504 Replacement of a Limited Passport or Requesting a Name Change



What you should know about replacing a limited passport or requesting a name change?

Name Change Eligibility Requirements

In order to use DS-5504 Form, your passport must have been issued less than 1 year ago and your name has legally changed due to marriage, divorce, or court order. [Click here to start the DS-5504 Form.](#)

IMPORTANT!

DS-82 Application Form and Procedures

If your current passport was issued more than 1 year ago, please apply using the [DS-82 Application Form](#) and Procedures. Submit evidence of your name change by enclosing a divorce, marriage, or court order certificate.

DS-11 Application Form and Procedures

If you cannot legally document your name change or are a minor under age 16, please apply using the [DS-11 Application Form](#) and Procedures. Submit evidence of your name change by enclosing a divorce, marriage, or court order certificate.

Evidence of U.S. Citizenship

Submit the following documents with your completed application:

- ✓Your valid **U.S. passport/passport card**
- ✓**Evidence** to support the change requested. If your name has changed, the name change document required may be a certified copy of your marriage certificate or a certified copy of a your order showing a seal and officiate/judge signature.
- ✓If you are re-applying because your U.S. passport book was limited in validity due to a lack of citizenship evidence or identity, please submit the necessary document as specified.
- ✓Passports limited in validity due to multiple losses cannot be extended.
- ✓One new **Passport Photo**
