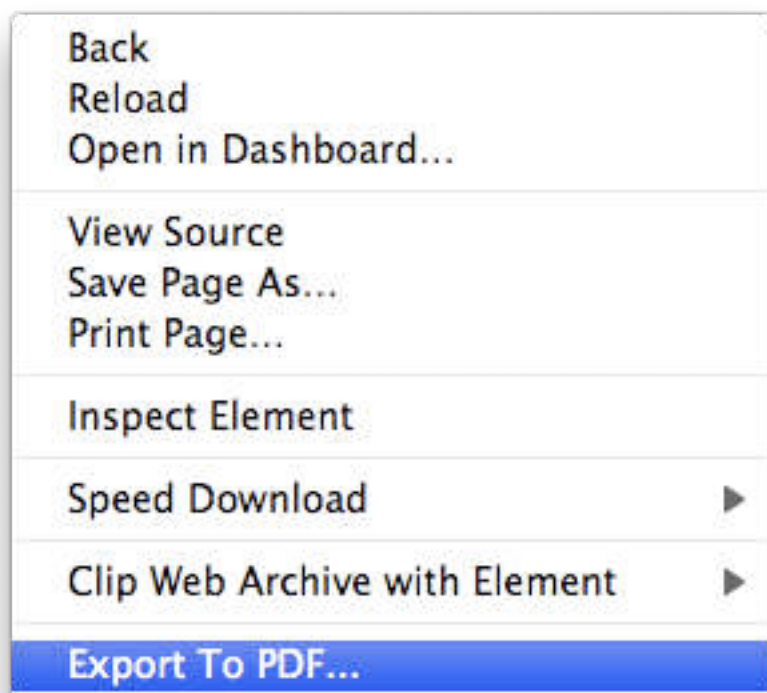

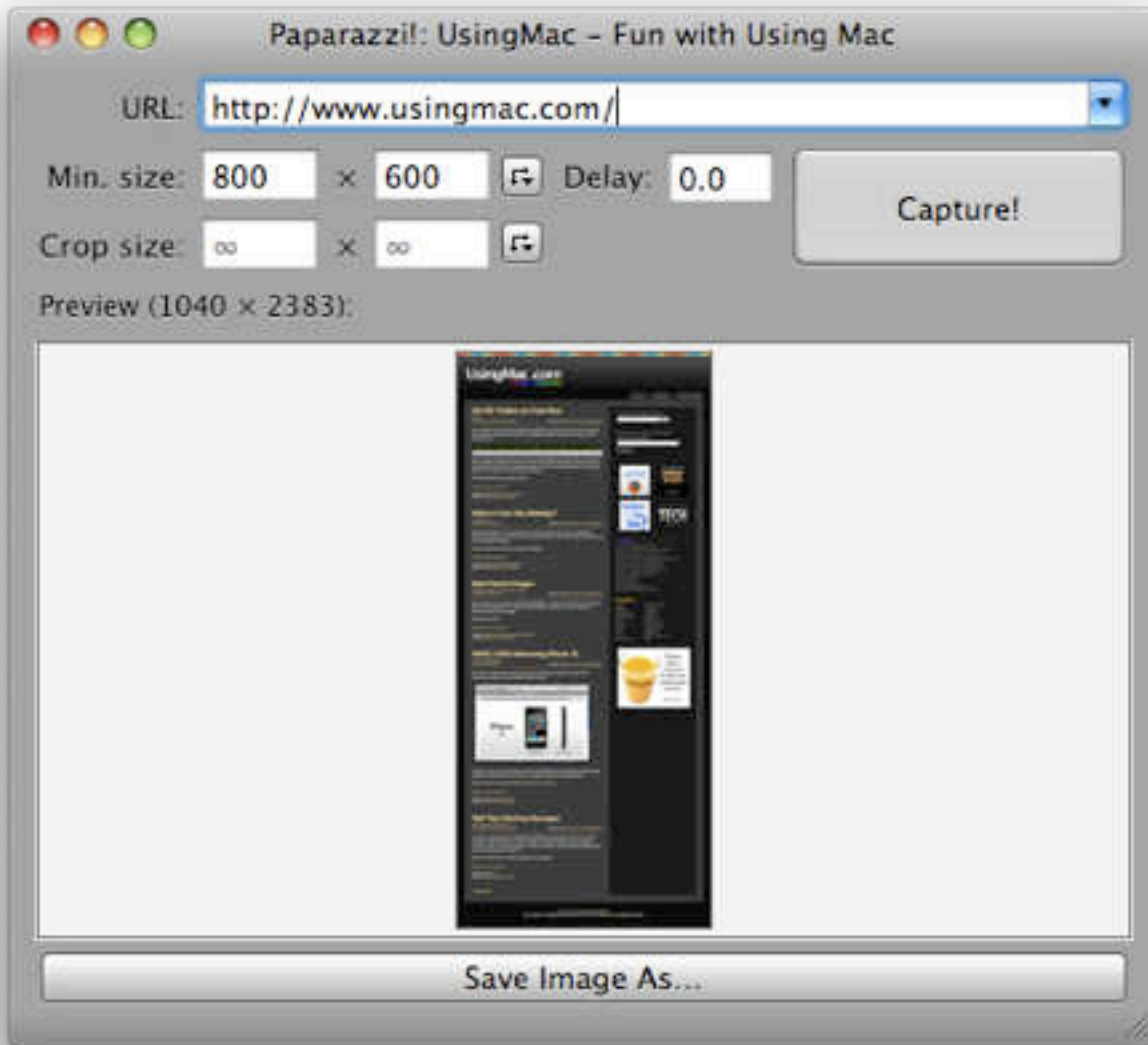
Soft Safari Plugin (<http://haoli.dnsalias.com/Saft/>)

Recently, I've found this nice Safari plugin called Saft (<http://haoli.dnsalias.com/Saft/>), which is a Shareware. Saft gives you ability to have a screenshot of entire webpage and save it as a PDF file with a single click.



Paparazzi! (<http://www.derailer.org/paparazzi/>)

If you don't like to export the webpage as PDF, you got other alternative application called Paparazzi! (<http://www.derailer.org/paparazzi/>). After downloading Paparazzi! 0.4.3, you can capture the entire webpage in various formats: JPEG, PDF, PNG or TIFF by providing the url for the page.
