CHANGING CHILD SUPPORT BY AGREEMENT

How much does this cost?

There is no fee for filing a petition when changing child support by agreement. This applies for changes to child support ONLY, and only when there is full agreement.

What happens next?

- Once all the documents have been filed they will be submitted to the Judge for review.
- If the Agreement is approved by the Judge it will become a court order and you will receive a copy in the mail.
- If there is missing documentation the clerk's office will contact you by mail letting you know that additional documents are needed before the agreement can be submitted for approval.

PLEASE NOTE:

If the parties DO NOT AGREE either party may file a PETITION TO CHANGE COURT ORDER [\(NHJB-2062-FS\)](#) along with the required filing fee of \$250.00. The other party will have to be served and a hearing will be scheduled.
