 - Only one entry form needs to be completed no matter how many poems are submitted. Supply all requested information. An incomplete entry form will disqualify a student's entry.
 - The entry form must be signed by a sponsoring faculty member.
 - All information on entry forms will be kept confidential and be used only for contest purposes. Winners will be notified by mail. Manuscripts will not be returned. Results will also be posted at <http://www.tri-c.edu>
