Tsofim Caravan brings together teens from all over San Diego to share in four different adventures! Teens bond and form close friendships as they enjoy summer experiences while traveling in their own bus. Highlights include a trip/tour to the Grand Canyon on the Grand Canyon Railway, white-water rafting at Kings River with Zephyr Whitewater Expeditions, a trip to Camp Mountain Chai, and water sports at Mission Bay Aquatic Center. Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Grades 10

Two 4-week sessions: Session 1: June 21-July 16 * Session 2: July 19-August 13 Camp Jaycee's Counselor-in-Training (CIT) program for selected 10th graders, is designed to develop leadership skills in all camp areas. Each session features training in conflict resolution, community service, age/group characteristics, activity planning, decision making and guest speakers. At the end of the 4-week session, campers receive a certificate of completion. This cohesive group gains work experience with a variety of ages under the supervision of trained Camp Jaycee staff. CIT's work with preschoolers through third grade campers and must commit to a full 4-week session or both sessions. A CIT application must be submitted along with a letter of recommendation, then each applicant will have a personal interview with the Camp Directors. LIT Leadership-in-Training (LIT) Grade 11

Two 4-week sessions: Session 1: June 21-July 16 • Session 2: July 19-August 13 LIT (Leader-in-Training) is geared towards those who want to become a camp counselor and are interested in becoming better leaders. Campers enter the program as individuals; and then by working together, the group becomes a cohesive team, learning cooperation, problem solving, developing skills in leadership and teamwork. They will be hands-on with younger campers, and work closely with counselors within a supervised program. Participants will build their own resumes with real life

experiences and gain first-hand knowledge working with children, earn community service hours, and help make a difference for themselves and other campers. Must commit to at least one full 4-week session. An LIT application must be submitted along with a letter of recommendation, then each applicant will have a personal interview with the Camp Directors. Broadway Jaycee Grades 8-12

ONE 2-week session: July 18-August 1 (Sun.-Thurs. & Sun., Aug 1, 4:00-8:00 p.m.)

Broadway/San Diego and Camp Jaycee have teamed up to bring this 2-week long Pre-Professional Musical Theatre Intensive specifically designed for actors, grades 8-12, interested in pursuing a career in the arts. Led by Jason Chase and other professional guest artists, the actors will take part in various theatre intensive workshops such as the proper alignment of the breathing core, scene study, scriptwriting and analysis, song interpretation and deconstruction, audition technique, stage combat, character development, monologue preparation as well as dance workshops in ballet, modern and jazz.

The actors will also have the opportunity to see the National Touring production of In the Heights at the beautiful Civic Theatre, downtown San Diego. Prior to the show, members of the cast will offer a dance workshop for the actors which will spotlight dance combinations from the show.

Works in-progress from the 2-week session are presented in the Cabaret Showcase on the final day.
