Military Service Record Request (SF-180)

Military personnel records can be used for proving military service, or as a valuable tool in genealogical research. Most veterans and their next-of-kin can obtain **free** copies of their [DD Form 214 \(Report of Separation\)](#) and other military and medical records.

Who may request these records:

- A **military veteran**, or
- Next of kin of a **deceased**, former member of the military. The **next of kin** can be any of the following:
 - Surviving spouse (that has not remarried), father, mother, son, daughter, sister, brother.

Please note: Records are accessioned into the National Archives, and become archival, **62 years after** the service member's separation from the military. This is a rolling date; hence, the current year, 2012, minus 62 years is **1950**. Records with a discharge date of **1950** or prior are archival and are open to the public. Records with a discharge date of 1950 or after are non-archival and are maintained under the Federal Records Center program. Non-archival records are subject to access restrictions.

Generally there is no charge for basic military personnel and medical record information provided to veterans, next-of-kin and authorized representatives from **Federal (non-archival) records**. If your request involves a service fee, you will be notified as soon as that determination is made.

However, **Archival OMPFs** are subject to the NARA fee schedule that authorizes the Agency to collect fees from the public for copies of archival records (44 USC 2116c and 44 USC 2307).

- A routine OMPF of 5 pages or less: \$20 flat fee
- A routine OMPF of 6 pages or more: \$60 flat fee (most OMPFs fall in this category)
- [Persons of Exceptional Prominence \(PEP\)](#) OMPF: \$.75 cents per page (\$15 minimum)
