The deadline for electronic submission of your abstract is December 02, 2014, at 11:00am CT (Noon EST, 9:00am PT). The research abstract submission form below and must be submitted electronically to the AMSSM National Office. Abstracts received after the deadline will be returned. DO NOT fax, email or mail your abstract to the AMSSM office.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA BEFORE SUBMITTING A RESEARCH ABSTRACT:

- The first author/presenter must be intimately involved in the research and be a member of AMSSM. Student Members can submit an abstract but must have a senior author listed that is a full member.
- You may submit more than one research abstract. However, each first author/presenter will only be permitted to give one podium presentation. If additional abstracts are accepted, they will be poster presentations.
- You CANNOT submit the same Research Abstract or Case Presentation sessions.
- Abstracts which have been presented elsewhere will be accepted. However, this work must not be submitted for publication as a full paper in a journal at the time of abstract submission or have appeared in print elsewhere (except in abstract form) prior to the AMSSM Annual Meeting.
- The abstract must be completed in the form below:
- Abstracts must contain results. Abstracts with phrases such as "...the results and conclusions will be presented..." will not be considered. Please do not include references or tables in your abstract.
- The maximum length of the abstract is **300 words** (not including title, authors, headings and acknowledgements).
- Authors must send their IRB Statement to Michele Lane
- Authors must indicate presentation preference.
- All research abstracts will receive a blind review to judge their scientific merit based on the following areas: significance of topic, originality of research, strength of study design, methodology, data interpretation and validity of conclusions, and contribution to sports medicine. This blind peer review will be performed by AMSSM Research Committee Members. You will be notified of the acceptance/rejection of your abstract in February 2015.
- All accepted research abstracts, regardless of type of presentation, will be published by the Clinical Journal of Sport Medicine, on the AMSSM website, and in the AMSSM Meeting jump drive.
