3:05 - 3:40	Motorcycle Ride Updates & Needs	Pam/Dawn	The TCSC is the only county committee that holds fundraising events. Last year we had two events and will only have one this year, for the 5 <sup>th</sup> Annual TCSC Motorcycle Ride. It's very similar to a poker run, with each rider obtaining stamps from the charities on their cards.
			Motorcycle Ride – Pam Scott, Co-Chair. The event will be held at the Lucky Eagle Casino, in Rochester. We need volunteers for this event!
			Typically T-Shirts are included in the cost of the pre-registration. Day of registration does not guarantee that a T-shirt will be provided to the riders. This is an incentive to get folks registering early!
			The group needs to work on sponsors and donations to help cover the cost of the T-shirts and/or review the registration fee to ensure the cost of the shirts is covered.
			Action Item: Pam will send a list of businesses that should be contacted about sponsoring the event so that committee members can assist in reaching out to them.
			Action Item: Sherry will work on the flyer for this year's ride that can be used when talking with businesses about sponsoring the event.
			The ride will be shorter this time with only four





			stops: (Capitol – CTW – Tenino Park – Lucky Eagle) and will end at noon, at the Lucky Eagle Casino.  Action Items: Philip is confirming CTW participation.  Action Item: Cindy will talk with Honda and AARP (oldest rider award) about sponsoring the event again.
