MSI College Scholarship Application Procedures

MSI scholarship awards, sponsored by the Harry & Leah Gudelsky Foundation, recognize players who have participated in and made contributions to MSI's soccer programs. Scholarships are awarded to individuals exhibiting academic excellence, leadership, community service, and commitment to soccer.

MSI annually awards scholarships to graduating seniors pursuing a college education. Parents, coaches, referees and school officials may nominate an individual, or the player may apply directly.

Eligibility:

Candidates for consideration should meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. Graduating senior planning to attend a college or university in the upcoming Fall.
- 2. Current player, with four or more seasons of play with MSI. Two seasons must be in the last two years.
- 3. In good standing with MSI, with no outstanding financial obligations.

- 1. Completed basic Application Form.
- 2. High school transcript, including SAT or ACT scores. If the transcript does not include scores, an unofficial report from the testing agency should be provided.
- 3. Chronology of soccer activities and accomplishments, as well as outreach and community activities. Please include participation with any and all teams. This listing should be as comprehensive as possible since all accomplishments will be considered.
- 4. Completed Essay including the following:
 a) discussion of how participation in youth soccer has enriched your life, and
 b) discussion of ways you have attempted to make contributions to your community through the game of soccer, and specifically with MSI.
 The essay should be double-spaced, typed and limited to 500 words.
- 5. An official copy of the letter/notification of acceptance from the college or university, along with documentation of college fees, scholarships/other grants, and financial aid package.

Materials must be received by May 12, 2014 to be considered.

The Scholarship Committee will make recommendations to the MSI Board of Directors, who will then make a final decision.
