DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION – January 6, 2015

The University of British Columbia (UBC) has partnered with The MasterCard Foundation to provide full scholarships to academically promising graduate students at the Master's level from Sub-Saharan Africa.

The vision of the program is to educate and develop bright yet economically marginalized young people in Africa who have demonstrated a "give-back" commitment and who seek to use their education to contribute to the transformation of the continent. The MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program is designed to provide students with holistic support, including:

- Comprehensive scholarships (school fees, living expenses, books, stipends, transportation);
- Academic curricula relevant to growth sectors in the Scholars' home countries;
- Mentoring and counseling, including academic and social support;
- Service and experiential learning (volunteerism, internships, social entrepreneurship); and
- Career counseling and connections to jobs in the Scholars' home countries.

To be eligible for consideration for The MasterCard Foundation Scholars Graduate Program at UBC, the applicant must:

1. have completed a Bachelor's degree or equivalent;
2. be a citizen of and have lived a significant part of their life in a Sub-Saharan African country;
3. present economically disadvantaged financial circumstances, and be able to show lack of financial means from family or other sources to pursue master's level education in their home country or elsewhere;
4. have achieved academic excellence under difficult circumstances;
5. show leadership qualities or potential;
6. demonstrate an interest in and commitment to giving back to their home community in ways that enhance the economic growth and social development of Africa, through engagement in activities in their current profession, university or community;

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7. be applying for a Master's degree in one of the following programs at UBC's Vancouver campus:

- **Sauder School of Business**
 - Full-Time Master of Business Administration MBA

- **Faculty of Forestry**
 - Master of Sustainable Forest Management (MSFM)
 - Master of Science (MSc)
 - Master of Applied Science (MASc)
 - Master of International Forestry (MIF)

- **Faculty of Land and Food Systems**
 - Master of Food and Resource Economics (MFRE)
 - Master of Food Science (MFS)
 - Master in Land and Water Systems (MLWS)

Please note that funds from the MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program at UBC cannot be applied to pursue programs at other academic institutions.

9. be a person who would require a study permit to study in Canada;

10. commit to returning to Africa after graduation from UBC in order to apply their training and skills to the betterment of others.

Please note that Convention refugees and students intending to become landed immigrants to Canada are not eligible for consideration for this award.

PART ONE: APPLICATION PROCESS TO FACULTY/UBC

1. Step One : Admissibility Submission

- a. Decide your Program(s) of Interest from the list above. Find your Graduate Program Coordinator from the list below:

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- b. Email the Graduate Program Coordinator for your Program(s) of Interest. In the email, state that you will be applying for the MasterCard Foundation Scholarship. Attach to your email a scanned copy of your:
 - i. academic records/transcript and
 - ii. curriculum vitae.

- c. Your Graduate Program Coordinator will accept Admissibility Submissions between on October 20th, 2014 and continue until December 1st, 2014.

2. Step Two: Additional Tests

- a. If your Bachelor's degree was not taught in English, make arrangements to take an English Proficiency Exam (TOEFL or IELTS) and have the results sent to UBC.
- b. If you intend to apply for the MBA, arrange to take the GMAT exam and have the results sent to UBC.

Be sure to take these exams by mid-December for UBC to receive your scores on time.

3. Step Three: MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program Eligibility Package

Both the UBC and MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program Applications are due January 6th, 2015.

In order for the Selection Committee to determine your eligibility for this scholarship, you must demonstrate financial need, a commitment to give back and how your education will contribute towards the transformation of your country or region in Africa. You must:

- a. **Complete the MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program Eligibility Form** below. If submitting a hand-written Eligibility Form, ensure that the document is clearly legible.
- b. **Submit the Personal Statements** as listed at the end of the Eligibility Form.
- c. **Provide two references.** The same references can be provided for academic application. However, a strong preference will be given to references that can attest to your leadership skills, commitment to community services and why you are suited for this award. (These references are in addition to the ones you have already submitted for your academic references).
- d. **Submit the Eligibility Form, Personal Statements and two references.** Completed packages can be submitted by:

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We strongly recommend you use email as this is faster and costs less. If you use a courier, please use an international courier service, as regular mail may take several weeks to reach Canada and UBC. Late or

incomplete packages cannot be accepted and UBC is not responsible for any packages not received by the deadline.

The deadline for the submission of the online Admission Application and completed MasterCard Foundation Scholarship Eligibility Package is **January 6, 2015**.

Results of the selection process will be made known by April 2015. Please note that the decisions of the MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program Selection Committee are final.

4. Step Four: UBC Graduate Program Application

- a. Apply Online: If your Admissibility Submission is approved, the Graduate Program Coordinator will provide you with instructions to submit an online application:

 - iii. Full-Time MBA program applications are submitted through the Sauder School of Business on-line application at: http://www.sauder.ubc.ca/Programs/MBA/MBA_Full_Time
- b. Application Fees: Application fees may apply. However, check with your Graduate Program Coordinator to see if you are exempt from paying the application fee.
- c. Ensure that all required supporting documents and official test scores are submitted by January 6st, 2015. Each program sets its own criteria for admission.
- d. Only students admitted to UBC will be considered for the MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program scholarship. Contact your Graduate Program Coordinator if you have questions about your UBC application.

5. Step Five: Reviewing Process

- a. In March 2015, Faculties will nominate admitted candidates for the MasterCard Foundation Scholarship. A university-wide selection committee will review scholarship applications from all three Faculties, rank them and select award recipients.

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- b. In April 2015, the MCF Scholar award recipients will be contacted and soon thereafter an announcement of award recipients will be made.
