BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 5004 amends Sections 56-5-6410 and 56-5-6420 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by increasing the age that a child must be in a passenger restraint system from 5 years of age to 7 years of age. The Bill also adds a height requirement, before a child can be allowed to sit in the front passenger seat.
