Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 by a Person in State Custody

Purpose

This form is for use by a person who is currently serving a sentence under a judgment in state court. The purpose of the form is to ask for relief from the conviction or sentence.

This form may also be used to challenge a state judgment that imposed a sentence to be served in the future, but the name of the state where the judgment was entered must be filled in where required. If challenging a federal judgment that imposed a sentence to be served in the future, file a motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in the federal court that entered the judgment.

This form may only be used to challenge a sentence in one court. If challenging a judgment entered by a different court (either in the same state or in different states), a separate petition must be filed.

Notice: Any false statements of a material fact may serve as a basis for prosecution and conviction for perjury.

Filling out the form

Fill out the attached form and answer each item completely in the space provided. Be sure all answers are typewritten or legibly handwritten.

Additional Pages

Additional pages are not permitted except with respect to the facts which you rely upon to support your grounds for relief. No citation of authorities need be furnished. If providing briefs or arguments, they must be:

- on white 8 ½ by 11 paper, and
- securely attached to this form.

Filing Fee

For the current filing fee, consult the Fee Schedule on the court's website at www.mied.uscourts.gov. If you do not have the filing fee, you must:

- Complete the attached Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis,
- Sign the application, and
- Have the application certified by an official of the institution in which you are imprisoned, indicating the amount of money and securities on deposit to your credit in any account in the institution. If your prisoner account exceeds \$150.00, the court will usually deny a request to file in forma pauperis.
