Are you a caring and dedicated person? Do you want a rewarding career where you make a difference in the lives of vulnerable adults? Do you like to get to the bottom of things and think you'd be a good investigator of reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation? If so, please apply!!

The Adult Protective Services Specialists (Human Services Specialist III) work to ensure vulnerable adults are safe by performing a variety of activities, including both direct and indirect assistance to vulnerable and/or incapacitated adults over age 18. APS Investigators assess, evaluate, and investigate allegations of abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation of vulnerable adults and determine if there is a need for any protective and/or social services. APS Investigators make time sensitive contacts with clients and family members, interviewing them and others who may have knowledge of the situation; research, obtain and analyze complex financial and medical documents (as appropriate), offer community-based supports and assistance, and testify at hearings if needed. When allegations are substantiated, perpetrators of adult abuse are placed on the public APS Registry.

At a glance...qualified candidates will have the following skill set:

- College degree from an accredited university applicable to this field
- One (1) year work experience focusing on provisions of services within the community or three (3) years case management/social work experience
- Be able to obtain a Level 1 Clearance Card from the Dept. of Public Safety
- Be able to drive and maintain a clean driving record (local travel required)
