DEPUTY STATE FIRE MARSHAL, CERTIFIED FIRE INSPECTOR III & PLANS EXAMINER

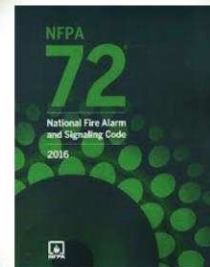

He is certified by the Minnesota Fire Service Certification Board as a Fire Inspector III, Plans Examiner, and Firefighter II. He currently represents the Minnesota State Fire Marshal Division on the NFPA 72® Technical Committee, Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Fire Code Development Committee, Fire Marshal Code Advisory Panel and the Construction Codes and Licensing Division Accessibility Review Board. He is currently serving on a national task group working with the Oklahoma State University to review fire alarm system notification appliances and the effects they can have on children with autism spectrum disorder and other sensory related disorders. In 2013, John was appointed by Minnesota Governor, Mark Dayton to the Minnesota Board of AELSLAGID; which establishes rules and regulations for those practicing in the architectural and engineering professions.
