

MEMBERSHIP POLICY 2013

A membership form must be completed to join Basingstoke Ice Skating Club (BISC). This can be completed by either the applicant if they are over 18 or their parent/guardian if they are under 18. There are three membership categories. Membership ice season is from January to September when the Christmas show rehearsal starts; all members are encouraged to take part in the Christmas show. Monthly payments must continue during the Christmas show season. (If two consecutive monthly payments are missed the Club assumes you are no longer a member and should you wish to rejoin the joining fee will be applicable)

THERE IS A "ONE OFF" JOINING FEE OF £25 FOR ALL NEW MEMBERS

A. FULL MEMBERSHIP OF BISC (£120 per year)

- Access to Sunday ice time hired by the Club.
- Represent Club at Open/National competitions.
- Opportunity to be selected to represent the Club at inter-club competitions, NTC etc.
- Master Class
- Edges Class most Sundays
- Club competitions, e.g., Edges & Bligh or Spin Jump Spiral.

Full Membership fees

£120 per year, payable either

- By standing order at £10 per month.
- Full payment yearly in advance.

B. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP OF BISC (£20 per year)

- No ice time is provided.
- Able to take part in all non skating club activities e.g. Holiday on Ice outings Associate membership is available for:
- Adults who do not wish to become full members.
- Synchro club members who require NISA Affiliation, Personal accident cover & liability insurance cover

Associate Fees

£20 per year payable in full

C. FURTHER EDUCATION 18+ LIMITED SKATING MEMBERSHIP (£45 payable in full)

- For students who are living away from home e.g. attending university who wish to remain members but will
 only be able to skate occasionally
- Limited ice time 15 sessions per year. Additional sessions can be purchased at £5 per session.
- Able to take part in all other club activities

Trial

This allows for new applicants to skate on Club ice to see if they want to become full members.

- A membership form must be completed before the applicant is allowed on Club ice.
- Must sign in with the Committee Member manning the Registration Desk each Sunday morning.
- The trial period must not exceed 1 WEEK.
