Who Should Attend? - Any employee benefit plan sponsors, officials, parties in interest, or service providers in the Philadelphia region (PA, Southern NJ, DE, MD, DC, VA, WV) who are interested in how to complete the application to correct fiduciary violations under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA).

**Learn How to apply and Get Approved** – You will receive instructions on how to complete the VFCP application and the requirements that are specific for anyone who submits these applications to the Philadelphia Regional office.

**Violations Covered** – While the VFCP program covers a total of 19 different violations, this particular webinar is focused exclusively on correcting late participant contributions (deferrals) and loan repayments.

Registration is limited to the first 10 registrants per webinar. You will need both an internet connection and phone access in order to take full advantage of the webinar.
