**ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL ID**

VALID FOR THE FOLLOWING PERSONNEL: U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corp., U.S. Coast Guard and active duty National Guard and Army Reserves.  
 All cards must have the words **GENEVA CONVENTIONS** at the bottom and on the back to indicate ACTIVE DUTY  
 Both the CURRENT and NEXT GENERATION card are valid and in circulation.  
 Official ID Name: Geneva Conventions Common Access Card (CAC)

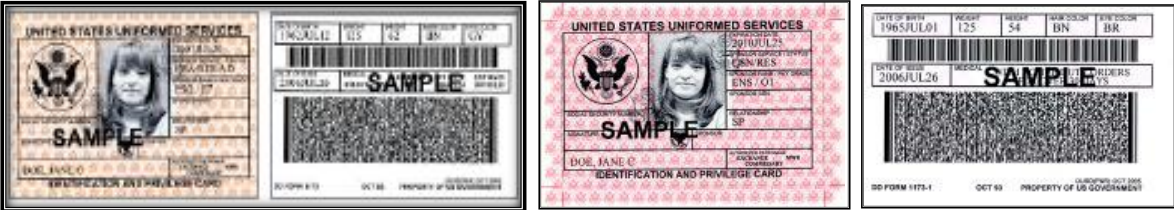
The chart compares two versions of the Geneva Conventions Common Access Card (CAC):

- CURRENT (VALID THROUGH OCTOBER 2009):**
  - Fields: FEDERAL IDENTIFIER, SERVICE, STATUS, OPTICALLY VARIABLE DEVICE (OVD), PAY GRADE, RANK, GHOST IMAGE, INTEGRATED CIRCUIT CHIP (ICC).
  - Example: Parker W. Christopher, Air Force, Active Duty, E-5, SSC1, 2004 SEP 15, 2009 SEP 15.
- NEXT-GENERATION (STARTING OCTOBER 2006):**
  - Fields: MEDICAL, GHOST IMAGE, DATE OF BIRTH, GENEVA CATEGORY, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, EXPIRATION DATE, FEDERAL IDENTIFIER, AFFILIATION, STATUS, PAY GRADE, RANK, INTEGRATED CIRCUIT CHIP (ICC).
  - Example: Doe, JOHN, G, 2001 JAN 15, JAN 2009, Uniformed Services of Health Care, Army, 2001 JAN 15, E-5, SSC1.

Both cards feature a "LOOK FOR: Geneva Conventions" label at the bottom.

VALID FOR THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL FAMILY MEMBERS : U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corp., U.S. Coast Guard, as well as National Guard and Army Reserves.  
 Official ID Name: DD Form 1173; DD Form 1173-1



Please note that the “Sponsor Service” field may contain any of the following USA, USN, USAF, USMC, USCG. If the bearer is with the National Guard or Reserves, those letters will be followed by “/NG” or “/RES.”
