1 – Form WA Organization

Use Case #	1
Use Case Name	Form a WA Organization
Use Case Desc	This use case is used to form any kind of domestic organization. In the flow the UI will ask what type of organization which may add some additional fields and invoke some additional rules
Primary Actor	– Professional or Non-professional
Precondition	None
Trigger	This is triggered by the person desiring to set up the organization
Basic Flow	<p>There is an optional login button which can be used at any time. The login button will give access to the user’s account, and credit card information, and also all addresses the user has historically used associated with themselves. (These will only be visible when they get to address sections)</p> <p>Ask the user what type of organization they are forming/registering (for Charities; Trusts; Fundraisers)(have some disclaimer to talk to an accountant and or a lawyer and point to the RCWs and WACs that are appropriate)</p> <p>The choices will include simple choices (Corp v. LLC v. Partnership v Trust) as well as compound choices (for instance Employee Cooperative which is really Corp + Non Profit + Employee Cooperative, but the user won’t see that)</p> <p>Invoke Sub Use Case T to validate proposed entity name. They can pick up a reserved name that they had previously reserved. (use case 20): No name validation for Charities; Trusts; Fundraisers</p> <p>Default today’s date to effective date. Have a button/ link to Use Case X “Set Effectivite Date” is effective date (incorporation date) different? Use Case X does not apply to Charities; Trusts; Fundraisers</p> <p>Ask for primary place of business. Primary place of business is validated to be a physical address in State of Washington. Store lat/long and reformatted physical address in the browser memory / cookies or shopping cart until posting time. See business rules for Charities; Trusts; Fundraiser on this topic of address.</p> <p>Ask for business mailing address. (default to same) Use Use Case D to set the communication preferences for the company itself.</p> <p>Ask for tenure (use use case X “Set EffectiviteDate(Enity, “To”)” not a number of years</p> <p>Use Use Case E to setup Registered Agent/PersonResponsible (Charities; Trusts;</p>

Fundraisers)

If Type = Partnership (LP or LLLP only) then ask for name, address, signature of all general partners for LLP ask for number of partners

Use Use Case I to set up Management

Use Use Case D to verify or set the communication preference for the person executing this filing.

If the Type = Corporation, ask user for classes of shares (“common” and “preferred” are the only current types, but presumably others are possible) and the number of shares authorized for each. Validate that they are integers ≥ 1

Depending on the type of entity (but why not do it for all) ask the purpose of the business. Ask but don't reject if LP “any lawful purpose” doesn't have a “powers” purpose. No profit get from the list (multiple check box)

Allow submission (upload) of articles of incorporation/Trust Instrument and supporting documents, have them supply a title to the document, and make sure it is Word, PDF or plain text (in order to scan and redact)

Provide character space for additional paragraphs or sections.

Support bulk filing via data for super users.

If Mass Trust check boxes for real estate.

If a FundRaiser invoke Use Case Y “Additional information for Fund Raiser”

If “Charitable” or “Trust” supply exempt status (501c3 or 501xx or xxx) and have them supply IRS letter to that effect. Are they tax exempt; what type of exemption; if they are (501c3 or 501xx or xxx) then upload IRS letter

A Charitable Organization that has not yet submitted their financials (because they are new for instance) will be on the list.

Recommend dropping asking for county, we can get that from geocoding If LLC ask if managed by members or managers (if they are member managed they must list members, if manage managers they list managers) members = owners

Calc Fee via Use Case B

On submit come back with the filed document (with UBI, seal etc)

Use Case Name	Register a non-WA Organization
Use Case Desc	<p>This use case is used to register any kind of foreign organization. In the flow the UI will ask what type of organization which may add some additional fields and invoke some additional rules.</p> <p>This is very similar to a domestic filing. There will be some rule differences, and in a foreign we don't literally create a new entity, but we create a reference to the entity from the home state, and set up the WA registration.</p>
Primary Actor	Professional and Non-professional
Precondition	None
Trigger	This is triggered by the person desiring to do business/solicit in WA
Basic Flow	<p>Only note the differences to 1 as we discover them.</p> <p>Need to ask what the legal business name is. Charities does not request 'legal' name</p> <p>We should check to see if it's available in WA (using T). If it isn't we should ask them for a DBA in WA name, and run use case T again. Can pick up either a reserved name or a registered name</p> <p>Ask them to attach Certificate of Existence from home state. (Future extension would be to do the integration)</p> <p>Primary business address need not be in Washington</p> <p>Ask for physical address where records are kept (check with GeoCoding service)</p> <p>Supply original incorporation (or partnership formation) date.</p> <p>Supply date began doing business in WA (could trigger past due fees)</p>

Use Case Name	Registered Agent Appointed Without Consent
Use Case Desc	If someone has nominated you as a registered agent without your consent, this use case allows you to be removed from the record as the Registered Agent.
Primary Actor	Registered Agent
Precondition	Registered Agent discovers they have been appointed without consent
Trigger	Someone will have named you as a registered agent for an entity. You will be notified (preferably by email) and given instructions for how to resign (Use Case __) or how to declare that you were appointed without consent (this Use Case, 5)
Basic Flow	<p>If you received an email notification stating that you have been designated as an entity's RA, it will have a link that will put you straight into the system.</p> <p>This use case will also show your default communication preferences (which are either those you have set up in your communication preferences, or if you have been nominated they will default to the physical address that was entered for you).</p> <p>You may click on "change communication preferences" to change your default, or you can change your preferences for this organization. For instance if you are an RA for many organizations when a new one nominates you, you could indicate a different email for these reminders.</p> <p>If you say you were appointed without consent, the system will out date your record. This will then trigger a notification to the entity and their timeline (60 days) for update of RA will kickoff and may eventually result in an administrative dissolution if not cured.</p>

Use Case Name	Implement Merger
Use Case Desc	Implementing a merger in our system
Primary Actor	OSOS Employee

Trigger	Someone has requested the merger
Basic Flow	<p>There will be a special form that allows us to lookup the acquiring company, then look up the UBI/EIN of the to-be-acquired company (some of the companies involved may not have a UBI). Check that they meet requirements for merger and then press a button, which does these things:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creates a temporal ownership link between the two (company A as of xxx date owns company B) • Company B's Effective To Date is set to the merger date • Merger Effective Date may be date of filing or may be delayed up to 90 days • There may be more than two companies involved. <p>There will be a place to upload the merger document</p>

Use Case Desc	For Corps this is the initial or annual report, for some entity types there is extra information to supply annually. For Charities; Fundraiser; Trust this is renewal.

Precondition	You have a new entity or an entity in good standing that is coming up to its anniversary/renewal date.
Trigger	This may be triggered by a notification, but it need not be. It could be from use case 1 Forming an Organization or 8 Review your Organizations or neither.
Basic Flow	<p>You will have to login to do this operation using use case A</p> <p>The system will find every entity that you are the PersonInCharge/ResponsiblePerson for and that are approaching their due date/renewal date. If you receive an email, this will point you at the specific entity that is expiring.</p> <p>The system will show you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Company name and UBI/Registration Number • Company mailing address • Company primary place of business • Registered Agent/ResponsiblePerson Name and Registered Agent/ResponsiblePerson Physical Address • It will also show a list of current management/ directors/ general partners/trustees • And a list of current places where you solicit (for Charities; Fundraisers; Trusts) • Nature of business/Charitable Purpose (use NAIC/NTEE codes) <p>For some entity types it will ask for additional information</p> <p>It will allow you to change any of this other than the name and UBI</p> <p>You then approve it, Use Case B calcs the fee and Use Case C collects the payment</p>

Trigger	Typically not triggered
Basic Flow	<p>You will have to login to do this operation using use case A</p> <p>The system will show you all the entities that you are a manager, director or partner.</p> <p>You can indicate either that the entity has gone out of existence or no longer required to register (for Dissolution/Closure), or for foreign entities you can indicate that they no longer have a nexus in WA (Revocation). You can supply an effective date up to 30 days from today for Non-profits; 90 days for Profits; no delay for Charities</p> <p>For many entity types the system will require a clearance certificate, which can be requested through use case 13</p> <p>The system will notify the other managers of the entity, and the RA.</p>

Some of these changes are bigger deals internally but we should shield the user from that.
