Re: Electricity Aggregation Program

Dear Business Owner,

On March 20, 2012, the Village of Barrington voters approved a referendum allowing the Village to enter into an electricity purchasing agreement to maximize the electricity supply savings for its residential and small business customers.

After an extensive bidding process, the Village selected MC Squared Energy Services, LLC (mc²), to provide eligible residents and small business customers with electricity supply savings. There is nothing you need to do in order to participate and enjoy this savings. mc² will automatically process your enrollment, unless you return the enclosed Opt-Out card within 14 days of the postmark date on this notice.

Your Low Electricity Rate: As an eligible member of this program, you will receive the mc² electricity supply rate identified below through your August 2014 billing cycle. For additional information, please see the enclosed terms and conditions.

Billing and Service: You will continue to receive a single bill from ComEd, with your mc² electricity supply charges included. You will continue to be eligible for all ComEd payment options, including e-bill, automatic bill payment and budget billing. In addition, if you are currently enrolled in the state’s Percentage of Income Payment Plan or LIHEAP program, you will continue to receive the program’s full benefits. ComEd continues to be responsible for the wires, poles, and all emergencies, including outage restoration.

Switching is Automatic: There is no switching fee from ComEd or from mc² and you do not need to do anything to participate. Your switch to mc² will occur automatically on the first available meter read date in August. After you are enrolled, ComEd will send you a letter confirming your selection of mc². Please see the enclosed terms and conditions for more information.

Your Opt-Out Option: You are not obligated to participate. If you wish to be excluded from this opportunity and remain with your current provider, you have until 14 days from the postmark date on this notice to return the enclosed Opt-Out card. You may also opt out by calling _____ or by sending an email with your name, address, account number and phone number requesting to opt out to _____.
