Services we provide

Irish HomeCare provides a comprehensive range of care and support services to enable people to live at home independently, safely and with dignity, for as long as possible. Care can be delivered in time slots ranging from a 30 minute period to 24 hours a day. Our service can vary from a few hours per week to an intensive reablement programme and is responsive to your needs. The care delivered is person centred with the clients' always coming first.

Our person-centred care programme

- 1.** An Irish HomeCare Team Leader meets with you and your family to discuss your individual needs and how we may assist you.
- 2.** Together we design a care plan tailored to meet your individual needs.
- 3.** You are introduced to and meet your carer before the service commences.
- 4.** The Team Leader remains involved in monitoring your care and will review your care programme with you on a regular basis.



Supporting our clients

Practical support:

- Light housework and meal preparation.
- Shopping, collecting prescriptions, medication prompts.

Personal support:

- Personal care, bathing and showering, continence care.
- Assistance with dressing, mobility and feeding.

Specialist support:

- Assistance with daily living - e.g. catheter care, oxygen facilitation.
- Palliative care, end of life care.
- Dementia care.
- Disability services – physical and intellectual.
- Post discharge from hospital.
- Convalescence in the home to aid recovery from illness.

Reablement: Care that builds confidence

An acute illness or a period of hospitalisation can sometimes result in a loss of confidence or the inability to carry out everyday tasks.

Our reablement care service helps people to recover those skills and regain confidence, through short-term intervention, empowering the person to continue to live in comfort in their own home.

Our reablement programmes are specifically designed for the individual, are delivered in their own home and normally last for a period of up to six weeks.
