## Details on Maps Required for Term Sheet (Exhibit A to the Second Supplement)

As noted on the Term Sheet provided on July 27, 2016 as Exhibit A to the Second Supplement, here are the details on map requirements for Plan submittal.

In Part Two, Section A, concerning Public recreational Access, using the GIS tool Elliott Forest Tax Lot Boundary (DSL data 2015) layer, delineate on a map the areas within the Elliott Boundary subject to the public access easement (or other mechanism).

In Part Two, Section C, using the GIS tool StandLayer 2016 layer, delineate on a map the areas that will be subject to a conservation easement (or other mechanism) for the protection of older forest stands. Attach a table describing the distribution of stand age (using stratification by 25 year intervals or less).

In Part Two, Section D, if adding additional areas beyond those identified on the stream map, using the GIS tool layers Ending\_of\_Fish\_Presence and Streams\_with\_Fish\_Presence, depict on a map any additional areas subject to the conservation easement (or other mechanism). Identify and calculate the total additional acreage that would be protected.
