Your Set Top Box Set-Up



STEP

Plug the composite breakout cable to the Video/Audio output port behind your set top box.



STEP

2 Connect the other end of the composite cable to your TV's "AUDIO/VIDEO LINE IN." Please make sure that you match white and red cable colors to the same colored outlets on Audio Line In. Connect the yellow video cable to your TV's Video Line IN yellow outlet.

Note: Some TV models may have their Audio/Video Line In outlets in front or at the back of the TV set. Also, some models may just have one Audio Line In. You may use either the white or red cable.

Your Internet Set-Up

IMPORTANT!

To receive TFC (TFC on Demand), your set-top box must connect to the internet using your existing broadband connection (DSL and cable modem).



▶STEP

3 Connect one end of the network cable into the DSL/cable modem's Ethernet/LAN port. Then turn ON your DSL/cable modem box.

NOTE: If your internet set-up includes a router, connect one end of the network cable into the router's LAN/Ethernet port. Then, turn ON your router.



Connect the power cable to the power port behind the set-top box. Then plug the set-top box's power adapter into a power outlet 100-240V.

Your TV Screen



7 Turn ON your TV set. Depending on your TV model, press the VIDEO or INPUT or LINE button of your TV set remote control to switch to the appropriate video channel.



▶STEP

Connect the other end of the Network or Ethernet cable to the WAN Ethernet port (ETHERNET) behind your set-top box.



▶STEP

Check the power light indicator on the front of the box. The STB is ON when you see the Green LED and is on STANBY mode when you see the Red LED.



STEP

8 The TFC Logo will appear. Please wait.



▶STEP

In case there will be system upgrades, you will be prompted to upgrade to a newer version of firmware manually. Simply follow the on-screen instructions and make sure that the power is always ON when performing the software upgrade.



▶STEP As soon as the upgrade process is complete, you will see the Activation Screen. Call the Technical Support hotline number indicated on the screen to complete your activation process.





STEP Once the box is activated, this will be the first menu screen that will be shown. Select TFC to start watching your TFC programs.
