

## Guide to a Test Drive – your checklist

	Once you have booked your test drive
	<ul> <li>We will send you an e-mail with all the details you need including a link to your Volkswagen showroom and how to find us.</li> <li>We will call you to confirm your test drive and check if you have any questions.</li> </ul>
	What to do beforehand
	<ul> <li>Make sure you have thought about what kind of test drive you need. Ensure the test drive route suits your lifestyle or the type of test you want to do.</li> </ul>
	What you need to bring with you
	<ul><li>Be sure to get there 10 minutes early.</li><li>Make sure you have an up to date driving licence and bring this with you.</li></ul>
	What happens on a test drive
	<ul> <li>The Test Drive takes about 10-15 minutes.</li> <li>The Salesperson will drive the car first, and give you instructions on the basics of the car.</li> <li>Then, in a safe, quiet location, the Salesperson will step aside and let you begin your drive.</li> </ul>
	Things to check on your test drive
	• Think about what is important to you – what are your needs? Make a checklist before you go. Do you need something to taxi your children in? Or the football team's bus? Would it be your mobile office? Or a quiet concert hall? Perhaps it's always full of dogs going to the park.
	After your test drive
	<ul> <li>Once you return to the Showroom, ask the Salesperson for any feature demonstrations you might have missed</li> <li>Take a brochure.</li> </ul>

- Talk to the Salesperson about buying and financing options.
