



Guide to a Test Drive – your checklist

☐ Once you have booked your test drive

- We will send you an e-mail with all the details you need including a link to your Volkswagen showroom and how to find us.
- We will call you to confirm your test drive and check if you have any questions.

☐ What to do beforehand

- Make sure you have thought about what kind of test drive you need. Ensure the test drive route suits your lifestyle or the type of test you want to do.

☐ What you need to bring with you

- Be sure to get there 10 minutes early.
- Make sure you have an up to date driving licence and bring this with you.

☐ What happens on a test drive

- The Test Drive takes about 10-15 minutes.
- The Salesperson will drive the car first, and give you instructions on the basics of the car.
- Then, in a safe, quiet location, the Salesperson will step aside and let you begin your drive.

☐ Things to check on your test drive

- Think about what is important to you – what are your needs? Make a checklist before you go. Do you need something to taxi your children in? Or the football team's bus? Would it be your mobile office? Or a quiet concert hall? Perhaps it's always full of dogs going to the park.

☐ After your test drive

- Once you return to the Showroom, ask the Salesperson for any feature demonstrations you might have missed.
- Take a brochure.
- Talk to the Salesperson about buying and financing options.
- Move forward with purchasing your dream car.
