

PRIORITY SIBLING ENROLLMENT

Incoming TK, K, and 1^{st} - 6^{th} grade <u>siblings</u> of *currently enrolled students in grades TK – 6th* will be able to pick up a registration packet from the Vallejo Mill Office from January 10- January 18.

You will complete registration by going to the Office of Student Support Services at the district office during the following dates to register your child: February 6, 7, and 8. No appointment is necessary; you may "walk in." <u>The deadline for this priority sibling registration for Vallejo Mill students must be completed by 4:30 p.m. on March 29th. If you miss these dates, you will need to wait until February 15th or May 8th depending on your child's grade level.</u>

WE NEED A GATE PARENT REP

If you are a parent of a GATE student and are interested in giving input at District GATE meetings, please inform our office. Vallejo Mill needs representation. Meetings left for the year are at Brookvale Elementary School from 7:00-8:30 pm on February 6 and April 10.

GATE PROGAM NOMINATION FORMS

Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) provides differentiated instruction for students with superior ability and highlevel academic performance. This year



all 3 rd grade students will have the opportunity to be tested for GATE. The process is automatic and does not require parents to initiate it. Any student whose parents do not want them to participate in testing must submit a typed opt out letter to the GATE Office by no later than January 15, 2017. Letters submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. Testing information was presented to 3rd grade parents during the months of October and November. Students in grades 4 or 5 who have not been tested in Fremont are automatically offered testing. Those students will be assessed with an ability test during the month of March. A letter will be mailed to the student's home address with an assigned testing session and for parental written permission. Failure to submit the written permission by the deadline specified in the letter will forfeit your child's opportunity to be tested. Nomination of those students is not necessary. If your child is new to the district this year and you have not received any information regarding testing by the end of February, please contact Mr. Schroeder at 510-657-2350 ext. 12325 or at jschroeder@fremont.k12.ca.us. If you opted out of testing as a 3rd grader and wish to participate as a 4th grader, you need to contact the GATE Office by phone indicating your wish for your child to test. If you opted out of testing as a 3rd grader and wish to participate as a 5th grader, you need to fill out and submit the Parent Nomination Form located on the GATE website. The window to submit the form is November 1, 2016 to January 15, 2017. For those students in 5th or 6th grade who have been tested and not identified, Teacher and/or Parent Nomination forms are accepted for review under other identification criteria. Additional information and forms are available in your child's school office or may be downloaded from the Gifted and Talented (GATE) Department's website. If you believe your child may require GATE services and is in the 5th or 6th grade, submit a completed nomination form to the GATE Office, 4210 Technology Drive, Fremont CA 94538, between November 1, 2016 and January 15, 2017. Faxes will not be accepted.

INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACTS

Independent Study Contracts may extend for not less than five (5) and not more than ten (10) consecutive school days.

- The parent must notify the school administrator in writing of intentions to go on a trip or to be absent for other non-medical reasons at least ten (10) days prior to the absence.
- A student may go on an Independent Study Contract <u>one</u> (1) time per school year in grades kindergarten to 12.
- Students <u>may not</u> be on an Independent Study Contract more than three (3) times while in grades kindergarten to 12.
- Independent Study Contracts that have been issued in previous school years will count towards the maximum number of three (3) while in grades kindergarten to 12.
 For example, a student that has participated in one (1) Independent Study Contract in the past has a maximum of two (2) Independent Study Contracts remaining until grade 12. A student that has participated in two (2) or more Independent Study Contracts in the past has a maximum of one (1) Independent Study Contract remaining until grade 12.
- Students who have previously been granted an Independent Study Contract and have not successfully completed all the assigned work, are not eligible for any subsequent short-term Independent Study Contracts.
- Students whose achievement is below grade level standards, based on multiple measures, in Language Arts or Math may not be eligible for short-term Independent Study Contracts.
- No Independent Study Contracts will be issued during the first twenty (20) school days of the school year.
- No Independent Study Contracts will be issued during the last twenty (20) school days of the school year.

When a student is absent for more than ten (10) continuous school days (other than illness), and an independent study contract has not been executed, his/her seat may be given to another student. Upon return, the student may be transferred to another school or alternative program if classrooms at the school of original enrollment are full.

Donations to a school, program, or the district may now conveniently be made online using a credit/debit card or eCheck. Donors may either log into their


