LEGEND

- Reminder: Run Direct Certification a minimum of three times per year with special emphasis during the weeks of Oct 15th - Oct 30th (New enrollment data through ISEE is now available - additional matches will be waiting)
- USDA State Match report due (FICA) - September 30th
- Verification Report due for sites that collect Free and Reduced Priced Meal Applications - November 15th
- Point of Service Site Review (Complete one for each site and keep on file) - February 1st
- Be prepared to compare Free/Reduced Eligibility with District ISEE Coordinator - 1st Friday in March
- Reimbursement Claim recommended to be submitted by the 10th of each month
- Part One of USDA Foods ordering process is to be completed by the 10th of each month
- Part Two of USDA Foods ordering process is to be completed and shipment finalized by the 25th of each month
- NSLP Renewal due (Rollover applications in MyIdahoCNP) - Last Friday in May
- Pull Community Eligibility Numbers - Complete first operating day in April
- Last Operating Day in October - Count the number of students with access to the NSLP or SBP as of the last operating day of October
- Count the number of applications approved as free and reduced as of October 1st
