2010 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- Scholarship funds are variable year to year.
- The first time you apply for an activity 50% of the registration cost could be paid. (Example: In one year you could apply for W.O.R.L.D. for 50%, Summer Conference for 50% and Activate Oregon for 50%)
- The next year, and for all future years, each activity could be awarded up to a 50% scholarship, depending on available funding and level of participation in the activity.
- The Linn County Extension office will keep a list of youth who have attended leadership activities and the amount of scholarship they have received.
- If additional scholarship money is available, and a financial need is presented, additional money **may** be awarded on a case by case basis.
