1 Overview	
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Background	Section 1205(a)(2) of the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (the Act) provides that the Secretary may make LDP's available to eligible producers that produce nongraded wool in the form of unshorn pelts for 2002 through 2007 crop years.
	Note : Unshorn pelts derived from an eligible loan commodity are not eligible for a marketing assistance loan.

Purpose	This notice provides general policies and procedures for:
	 implementing the 2002 through 2007 crop year LDP program for unshorn pelts accepting LDP requests using the new CCC-709 PELT and CCC-633 PELT authorization to disburse LDP's for unshorn pelts.

2 General Policies	
A General Policy Overview	 Nongraded wool in the form of unshorn pelts are only eligible for an LDP. General LDP policies in 8-LP are applicable to LDP's for unshorn pelts. Note: The policy included in this notice is specific to unshorn lamb pelts and will be incorporated as a subpart in 8-LP.
B Producer Eligibility	 To be eligible for an LDP for unshorn pelts, producers must: meet the definition of an eligible producer according to 8-LP comply with highly erodible land conservation (HELC) or wetland conservation (WC) provisions according to: 6-CP regulations in 7 CFR Part 12 have beneficial interest in the commodity, according to 8-LP, paragraph 129 own the unshorn lamb for at least 30 calendar days before the date of slaughter sell the unshorn lamb for immediate slaughter or slaughter the unshorn lamb for personal use. Note: Immediate slaughter is considered slaughter of the lamb within a 7 to 10 calendar day period after loss of beneficial interest. Personal use is considered slaughter for use of the pelt as clothing, shelter, or other personal use determined acceptable by COC.

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Ineligible Producers	The following producers are ineligible to request benefits on unshorn pelts produced from unshorn lambs purchased from eligible producers:

	Note: Producers who sell feeder lambs to a feeder lamb buyer are ineligible for an LDP on the unshorn pelt. However, the feeder lamb buyer is eligible if the feeder lamb buyer is an eligible producer according to subparagraph B.		
D Commodity	To be eligible for an LDP, the unshorn pelt must:		
Eligibility	 have been produced by an eligible producer 		
	 be produced from a live unshorn lamb of domestic origin in the United States at the time beneficial interest is lost. 		
E Applicable LDP Forms	 When requesting an LDP for unshorn pelts, producers must complete: CCC-709 PELT, according to paragraph 5, for field direct LDP's CCC-633 PELT, according to paragraph 6, for basic LDP's. 		
F Final Loan Availability Date	The final loan availability date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts is January 31 of the year following the year in which the unshorn lamb is slaughtered. For the 2002 crop year only, the final loan availability date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts has been extended to March 31, 2003. For 2003 through 2007 crop years the final date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts will remain January 31 of the year following the year in which the unshorn lamb is slaughtered.

H Unshorn Pelt Definition	An <u>unshorn pelt</u> is the removed skin and attached wool from a slaughtered lamb that has never been shorn.	
I Standard Weight	LDP's for unshorn pelts will be based on a standard weight of 6.865 pounds per pelt.	

3 Beneficial Interest Policies

A 2002 Crop Beneficial Interest Waiver for LDP's	Eligible producers of unshorn pelts who lost beneficial interest before the end of the 2002 crop year on December 31, 2002, are eligible to request an LDP based on the date beneficial interest was lost in the unshorn lamb(s). Producers are required to provide acceptable production evidence which indicates the date beneficial interest was lost with the LDP request. See subparagraph 4 E for acceptable production evidence requirements.
	LDP requests for unshorn pelts must be submitted by the final LDP request date provided in subparagraph 2 F:
	• on CCC-709 PELT for producers who:
	lost beneficial interest during the 2002 crop yearslaughtered an unshorn lamb for personal use
	• on CCC-633 PELT for producers who maintain beneficial interest in the unshorn pelt.
	County Offices shall honor any LDP requests for unshorn pelts submitted to the County Office during the 2002 crop year if the request was made either:
	in writingon existing CCC-633 LDP or CCC-709.
B Direct Sell to Lamb Slaughter Companies	Eligible producers who sell unshorn lambs directly to a slaughter lamb company for immediate slaughter or have the unshorn lambs processed for meat will lose beneficial interest the earlier of the following:
	delivery to the slaughter lamb companyreceipt of any payment for the unshorn lambs.
	Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.

	Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.
D Butcher Sells	Eligible producers who sell unshorn lambs directly to a butcher for immediate slaughter will lose beneficial interest the earlier of the following:
	 invoicing of the unshorn lambs delivery of the unshorn lambs to the butcher receipt of any payment for the unshorn lambs.
	Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.
E Personal Use	Eligible producers who slaughter unshorn lambs for personal use will lose beneficial interest on the date the unshorn lamb is slaughtered. For unshorn pelts slaughtered for personal use, the producer must complete CCC-709 PELT, Part D, within 60 calendar days after the date of slaughter.

G **Special** Eligible producers of unshorn pelts produced from slaughtered lambs who lost Beneficial beneficial interest during the 2003 crop year, between the period of January 1, 2003, through February 21, 2003, when the policy and procedure was Interest not available to make a request for unshorn lambs, are eligible to request an LDP Exception based on the date beneficial interest in the commodity was lost. LDP requests for this beneficial interest exception must be submitted no later than March 31, 2003. Producers who lost beneficial interest between January 1, 2003, and February 21, 2003, must submit CCC-709 PELT by March 31, 2003. Producers who retain beneficial interest must request LDP's in the normal manner according to normal beneficial interest rules provided in this notice.
