1 Overview

A

Background

Section 1205(a)(2) of the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (the Act) provides that the Secretary may make LDP's available to eligible producers that produce nongraded wool in the form of unshorn pelts for 2002 through 2007 crop years.

Note: Unshorn pelts derived from an eligible loan commodity are **not** eligible for a marketing assistance loan.

B

Purpose

This notice provides general policies and procedures for:

- implementing the 2002 through 2007 crop year LDP program for unshorn pelts
- accepting LDP requests using the new CCC-709 PELT and CCC-633 PELT
- authorization to disburse LDP's for unshorn pelts.

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2 General Policies

A

General Policy Overview

Nongraded wool in the form of unshorn pelts are only eligible for an LDP. General LDP policies in 8-LP are applicable to LDP's for unshorn pelts.

Note: The policy included in this notice is specific to unshorn lamb pelts and will be incorporated as a subpart in 8-LP.

B

Producer Eligibility

To be eligible for an LDP for unshorn pelts, producers must:

- meet the definition of an eligible producer according to 8-LP
- comply with highly erodible land conservation (HELCS) or wetland conservation (WC) provisions according to:
 - 6-CP
 - regulations in 7 CFR Part 12
- have beneficial interest in the commodity, according to 8-LP, paragraph 129
- own the unshorn lamb for at least 30 calendar days before the date of slaughter
- sell the unshorn lamb for immediate slaughter or slaughter the unshorn lamb for personal use.

Note: Immediate slaughter is considered slaughter of the lamb within a 7 to 10 calendar day period after loss of beneficial interest. Personal use is considered slaughter for use of the pelt as clothing, shelter, or other personal use determined acceptable by COC.

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2 General Policies (Continued)

C

Ineligible Producers

The following producers are ineligible to request benefits on unshorn pelts produced from unshorn lambs purchased from eligible producers:

- lamb slaughter companies
- order buyers representing lamb slaughter companies
- processors.

Note: Producers who sell feeder lambs to a feeder lamb buyer are ineligible for an LDP on the unshorn pelt. However, the feeder lamb buyer is eligible if the feeder lamb buyer is an eligible producer according to subparagraph B.

D

Commodity Eligibility

To be eligible for an LDP, the unshorn pelt must:

- have been produced by an eligible producer
 - be produced from a live unshorn lamb of domestic origin in the United States at the time beneficial interest is lost.

E

Applicable LDP Forms

When requesting an LDP for unshorn pelts, producers must complete:

- CCC-709 PELT, according to paragraph 5, for field direct LDP's
 - CCC-633 PELT, according to paragraph 6, for basic LDP's.

F

Final Loan Availability Date

The final loan availability date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts is January 31 of the year following the year in which the unshorn lamb is slaughtered. **For the 2002 crop year only**, the final loan availability date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts has been extended to **March 31, 2003**.

For 2003 through 2007 crop years the final date to request an LDP for unshorn pelts will remain January 31 of the year following the year in which the unshorn lamb is slaughtered.

G

**Payment
Limitation**

LDP's received by a producer for unshorn pelts are included in one \$75,000 payment limitation per crop year for the following commodities:

- wool
 - mohair
 - peanuts
 - honey.

H

**Unshorn Pelt
Definition**

An unshorn pelt is the removed skin and attached wool from a slaughtered lamb that has never been shorn.

I

Standard Weight

LDP's for unshorn pelts will be based on a standard weight of 6.865 pounds per pelt.

3 Beneficial Interest Policies

A

2002 Crop Beneficial Interest Waiver for LDP's

Eligible producers of unshorn pelts who lost beneficial interest before the end of the 2002 crop year on December 31, 2002, are eligible to request an LDP based on the date beneficial interest was lost in the unshorn lamb(s). Producers are required to provide acceptable production evidence which indicates the date beneficial interest was lost with the LDP request. See subparagraph 4 E for acceptable production evidence requirements.

LDP requests for unshorn pelts must be submitted by the final LDP request date provided in subparagraph 2 F:

- on CCC-709 PELT for producers who:
 - lost beneficial interest during the 2002 crop year
 - slaughtered an unshorn lamb for personal use
- on CCC-633 PELT for producers who maintain beneficial interest in the unshorn pelt.

County Offices shall honor any LDP requests for unshorn pelts submitted to the County Office during the 2002 crop year if the request was made either:

- in writing
 - on existing CCC-633 LDP or CCC-709.

B

Direct Sell to Lamb Slaughter Companies

Eligible producers who sell unshorn lambs directly to a slaughter lamb company for immediate slaughter or have the unshorn lambs processed for meat will lose beneficial interest the earlier of the following:

- delivery to the slaughter lamb company
- receipt of any payment for the unshorn lambs.

Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.

3 Beneficial Interest Policies (Continued)

C

Lamb Auction Sells

Eligible producers who sell unshorn lambs through an auction or sell to an order buyer representing a slaughter lamb company will lose beneficial interest the earlier of the following:

- invoicing of the unshorn lambs
- delivery of the unshorn lambs to the order buyer
- receipt of any payment for the unshorn lambs.

Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.

D

Butcher Sells

Eligible producers who sell unshorn lambs directly to a butcher for immediate slaughter will lose beneficial interest the earlier of the following:

- invoicing of the unshorn lambs
- delivery of the unshorn lambs to the butcher
- receipt of any payment for the unshorn lambs.

Note: This determination should be used as a general business rule and should not take precedence over the terms of a contract between the buyer and seller that would cause beneficial interest to be lost at an earlier time.

E

Personal Use

Eligible producers who slaughter unshorn lambs for personal use will lose beneficial interest on the date the unshorn lamb is slaughtered. For unshorn pelts slaughtered for personal use, the producer must complete CCC-709 PELT, Part D, within 60 calendar days after the date of slaughter.

COC must determine reasonableness based on any of the following:

- herd certification on CCC-709 PELT, Part B
 - production evidence
 - feeding records/receipts
 - normal business practices of the producer
 - general COC knowledge.

F

Retained Pelts

Producers who retain beneficial interest in an unshorn pelt produced from a slaughtered lamb may request an LDP on CCC-633 PELT, based on the date of request, if the unshorn pelt retained is:

- preserved
 - maintained
 - stored for future marketing or processing.

G

**Special
Beneficial
Interest
Exception**

Eligible producers of unshorn pelts produced from slaughtered lambs who lost beneficial interest during the 2003 crop year, between the period of January 1, 2003, through February 21, 2003, when the policy and procedure was not available to make a request for unshorn lambs, are eligible to request an LDP based on the date beneficial interest in the commodity was lost. LDP requests for this beneficial interest exception must be submitted no later than **March 31, 2003**.

Producers who lost beneficial interest between January 1, 2003, and February 21, 2003, must submit CCC-709 PELT by March 31, 2003.

Producers who retain beneficial interest must request LDP's in the normal manner according to normal beneficial interest rules provided in this notice.

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4 LDP Rates for Unshorn Pelts

**A
Effective LDP
Rate**

The LDP rate is the rate in effect on the day of:

- request, if beneficial interest is maintained on the date of request
- slaughter, if slaughtered for personal use
- delivery, if sold directly from the farm/ranch/feedlot location to a buyer.

The request date is the date CCC-709 PELT is received in the County Office. County Offices shall date stamp CCC-709 PELT to verify the date the request is received.

The slaughter date is the date the unshorn lamb is slaughtered for personal use. CCC-709 PELT must be submitted to the County Office before slaughtering the unshorn lamb. The producer must complete CCC-709 PELT, Part D within 60 calendar days after slaughtering the unshorn lamb.

The delivery date is the date the unshorn lambs are delivered to a buyer, processor, etc., for field direct LDP's. CCC-709 PELT must be submitted by the producer before delivery or loss of beneficial interest in the unshorn lambs.

**B
LDP Rate**

The LDP rate is determined by the amount the nongraded wool loan rate exceeds the CCC-determined value in the applicable region where the farm records are maintained.

The nongraded (greasy) wool regional loan rates applicable to the 2002 and 2003 crop year of unshorn pelts are as follows.

Region	Loan Rate
Region 1	\$0.42
Region 2	\$0.40
Region 3	\$0.38

LDP is calculated by multiplying the LDP rate time the LDP quantity of unshorn pelts requested.

LDP rates for multiple deliveries will be based on procedure in 8-LP.

Announcing
Posted Prices**

The regional posted prices for nongraded (greasy) wool that are used to calculate the CCC-determined value to determine the LDP rate for unshorn pelts will be announced each Tuesday at 3:00 p.m., e.t until further notice. The posted prices will become effective Wednesday at 12:01 a.m. e.t

**D
Unshorn Pelt
LDP
Computation**

LDP for unshorn lamb pelts will be calculated by multiplying the effective LDP rate times the standard weight for an unshorn pelt of 6.865 pounds. The result of that computation is then multiplied by the quantity of unshorn pelts.

Example: \$0.29 (effective LDP rate)
 x 6.865 (standard weight)
 \$1.99 (payment per pelt)

Payment per unshorn pelt	\$1.99
Quantity of unshorn pelts	<u>x 10</u>
Payment	\$19.90

Acceptable
Production
Evidence**

Determine requirements for acceptable production evidence used to determine the rate in effect when beneficial interest is lost according to 8-LP, paragraph 535. Other acceptable forms of production evidence specific to unshorn pelts includes, but are not limited to, the following:

- receipts for feed
 - kill sheets from the lamb slaughter company
 - veterinary records
 - IRS inventory records
 - farm credit balance sheets
 - private insurance documents.

Producers of unshorn pelts shall complete CCC-709 PELT according to the following table.

If the producer is requesting LDP in person, the County Office may assist the producer, as applicable.

PART C - PRODUCER'S CERTIFICATION

14. I certify that all information entered on this form is true and correct. By completing and reviewing Part A and Part B, and by signing this form the producer(s) ("Producer") hereby enters into this agreement with the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) with respect to the commodity described in this Part and agrees that the loan deficiency payment (LDP) rate in effect for the unshorn lamb pelt on the date of delivery of the unshorn lambs to the processor, buyer, warehouse, or cooperative if the unshorn lambs are delivered directly from the farm / feed lot / ranch, location to the processor, buyer, warehouse, or cooperative or agrees to the rate in effect on the date of slaughter if slaughtered for personal use. The producer further understands that with respect to the commodity described in this Part: (a) to receive payment for the unshorn lamb pelt, a request for payment must be made at the County FSA Office where the farm records are maintained; (b) the unshorn lamb that produced the unshorn pelt must have been alive and unshorn at the time beneficial interest was lost; (c) the payment will be based on a standard weight of 6.865 pounds per pelt; (d) that if the commodity is delivered to a farm storage, except for temporary storage or immediate drying, this agreement becomes null and void and a CCC-633 PELT for unshorn pelts must be requested before the producer loses beneficial interest in the commodity; (e) any false claim or statement made may lead to civil liability or criminal prosecution; (f) this LDP may be selected for spot check and the producer will be required to provide supplemental documents to determine program eligibility; (g) that slaughter lamb companies are ineligible for this benefit and this LDP request is not being submitted on behalf of a slaughter lamb company; (h) this agreement remains in force until such time it is revised or terminated on or before the earlier of the date of delivery or sale of the unshorn lambs for slaughter; (i) CCC may require copies of sales contracts for the production represented by this application; (j) CCC shall require the refund of the LDP amount, plus interest from the date of payment if the producer is later determined by CCC to be ineligible for the LDP; and (k) CCC shall assess liquidated damages in accordance with 7 CFR Part 1421 if the producer misrepresented the eligible commodity indicated above. I also understand that if the Producer sold unshorn lambs to a feeder lamb buyer for further feeding before slaughter that the feeder lamb buyer and NOT the producer who sold the unshorn lambs to the feeder lamb buyer is eligible to receive an LDP for the unshorn lamb pelts.
