	Certification of Trust form (NHJB-2634-P) if there is reference to an intervivos trust in the will.
	Affidavit of Counsel as to Propriety of a Foreign Will/Codicil to be Admitted into Probate form (NHJB-2146-P) is needed if the Will/Codicil being filed was written in another state or foreign country.
	Photo identification may be required.

	Waiver of Administration Affidavit form (NHJB-2144-P) must be filed within 6 months to a year from the date you are appointed as Administrator.
