


BenMAP 3.0 Installation Instructions

Preliminary Steps

BenMAP requires administrative rights to the computer. Verify that the User Account where you are installing BenMAP is a member of the Computer Administrators group. On a standalone Windows XP machine, do this by selecting the following on your desktop:

Windows Start...Control Panel...User Accounts


- The User Account where you are installing BenMAP should be listed as Computer administrator (in this case, ABCG is the user). On some networks, this window may not appear or may be different. If you are unable to determine if you have administrative rights, contact your local system administrator.



Verify that “File and Printer Sharing for Microsoft Networks” is enabled on the computer. Do this by selecting the following on your desktop:

Windows Start...Control Panel... Network Connections

- Select “Local Area Connection” and then right click and select “Properties”
- Under “Local Area Connection Properties” make sure that “File and Printer Sharing Microsoft Networks” is checked.
- Click OK to exit.



Verify that the computer has at least ~2.3GB of space on the C:\ Drive.

If your computer meets the above requirements, you should be able to install BenMAP.

BenMAP Installation

Download BenMAP 3.0 from <http://www.epa.gov/air/benmap/download.html>. Save the file, either to the default location or to a location you provide. Do not select open. The file may take some time to download. Make sure you take note of where the file is being downloaded.





The installation files **must** be extracted from the zip file in order for the installation to proceed. Open the downloaded folder. Within Windows XP, if you browse to the "USSetup.exe" file within the BenMAP 3.0 Installer folder (all within the BenMAP3014Installer.zip file) and attempt to run the file from within the zip file, you will be notified that you need to extract all files. Select "Extract All".



The "Extraction Wizard" will open. Click next and select a location for the extracted files. You can save the extracted files to the default location or to a location you provide. After extraction is complete, select "Finish".



Open the extracted folder and select "USSetup.exe". Run "USSetup.exe" to begin the BenMAP Installation process.



The following security warning will appear. Click “Run” to allow.



This will start the BenMAP installer. Select “Install BenMAP 3.0 Database”.




The database engine installation program will then start.




After the database engine has installed, you will be brought back to the BenMAP installation program where you can now select “Install BenMAP 3.0”.



The following prompt will appear, and you can select “OK”. This process may take a considerable time to complete, so once started **do not end the program if it appears to be stalled**.



After the BenMAP data has been loaded into the database, the following prompt will appear and you can again select “OK”.




Now the BenMAP program itself will install. The Windows Installer “Preparing to install...” window will briefly appear.



Select "Next" on the prompt that appears.



And select "Install" on the following screen.



The installation will run briefly, displaying the following screen.



After installation is complete, the following screen will appear. Select "Finish".



On the Start menu, if you now select “Launch BenMAP 3.0” from the “BenMAP 3.0” program group that was created the program will start. First the splash screen will appear.
