Because the answers must be your own, you should fill out the questionnaire without consulting any other prospective juror.

In the first part of the trial, the jury's job will be the same as it would be in any other criminal case — to decide whether the defendant is guilty or not guilty of the crimes charged. Only in the event the jury decides the defendant is guilty of murder in the first degree does it move to the second part of the trial. In the event of a second part of the trial, the jury will hear additional evidence in order to decide a penalty.

Because the death penalty is being sought by the United States, the court and lawyers need to know about your opinions and personal views toward the death penalty.
