NEWS RELEASE

Michael Spivey and Marques Reavis were charged today in a three-count indictment¹ alleging that they conspired to commit robbery which interfered with interstate commerce, committed a robbery which interfered with interstate commerce, and used and carried a firearm during and in relation to a crime of violence, announced United States Attorney Michael L. Levy. The indictment specifically charges that on June 25, 2009, at gunpoint, the defendants robbed the McDonalds Restaurant located at 308 N. Lewis Road in Royersford, Limerick Township, in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

If convicted the defendants each face a maximum possible sentence of life imprisonment, with a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 7 years, five years supervised release, and a \$750,000 fine.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Tomika N. Stevens.
