

GODDARD SPACE FLIGHT CENTER APPLICATION FOR FARE SUBSIDY

The Transportation Fringe Benefit Program (TFBP) was established to reduce petroleum consumption and traffic congestion, and to improve air quality by encouraging the use of public mass transportation when commuting to and from work. GPR 9730.1 sets forth the policies and procedures for the TFBP at GSFC.
