<u>Table 2A on page 35 of 58 Traditional Cellular Telephone, US Based Service</u>. Please clarify: are you asking the cost of incoming or outgoing text messages? Or are you asking for the price of a text messaging package?

#### ANSWER #1

The listing is regarding the cost of originating a text message (outgoing) from a phone provided by the vendor. If incoming messages result in a cost, include that price in table 10.

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### **QUESTION #2**

<u>Table 7 on page 51 of 58 ISP Access Data Service Costs</u>. Interested in request for Rev B EVDO. Rev 0 Entry level, most carriers are Rev A advanced. Do you want carriers to propose Rev A?

### **ANSWER #2**

Provide prices for services as defined in TIA-856 Rev B in Table 7. Provide any other offerings in Table 10 Balance of Product Line.

### **QUESTION #3**

Please insert the following additional language in the Agreement, as Section 5.5 of Section 5. Contract Price: Limitation on Price Payment.

5.5 NEITHER PARTY IS LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LOST PROFITS OR LOST BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES), PUNITIVE OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES, OR ATTORNEYS' FEES.

### **ANSWER #3**

See Addendum #4, Paragraph #3.

### **QUESTION #4**

Can the State please provide Addendum's #1 and #2 that were issued on December 12, 2008 in WORD format, as the State's changes to various sections and Price Tables of the RFB would necessitate re-typing the applicable portions of the document?

### **ANSWER #4**

### **QUESTION #5**

1.18 - Bid Content — All terms, conditions and related items as presented in this document as released will take precedence over changes provided in vendor proposals. Vendor requests the following language be added to this requirement: "...except when they are presented as part of a vendor's exceptions and clarifications to the RFB requirements/terms and conditions."

#### **ANSWER #5**

No, material exceptions or modifications to the terms and conditions will not be allowed after the vendor inquiry period.

# **QUESTION #6**

<u>Form P-37, Section 7, subsection 7.3</u>. Does the sentence, 'In the event of any dispute concerning the interpretation of this Agreement, the Contracting Officer's decision shall be final.' refer to personnel disputes?

# **ANSWER #6**

No, Contract disputes.

### **QUESTION #7**

Form P-37, Section 8, subsection 8.1. Is there a materiality standard to this section 8.1?

### **QUESTION #8**

Form P-37, Sections 12 and 13. Will the State be providing an addendum deleting or editing Sections 12 and 13 as it did in the 2005 RFB?

### **QUESTION #9**

Verizon Wireless plans to submit its exceptions and clarifications to the RFB requirements with its final bid. If this is not acceptable to the State, please let us know as soon as possible.
