Born and raised in the San Gabriel Mountains of California, Ruthanne moved to England in 1968 to marry and discovered another love, pottery. Discovering the lure and beauty of handmade pottery in a Cardiff market, she taught herself wheel throwing using illustrations from books and working on a rented wheel. Her love of the medium, lead Ruthanne to Goldsmith's College in London where she immersed herself in a postgraduate course in ceramics.



Working as a full time potter since 1989, Ruthanne has developed an artistic style emphasizing function and natural forms. Her mastery of soda glazing and a book authored on the subject, has lead to her work being procured by sixteen museum collections and private collections in Europe, Asia, England and the USA.

Soda glazing accentuates the lines and marks of the pottery and the soft natural forms. Creating areas of light and shadow, shiny and matt surface textures are the goal. Teaching around the world and active in a number of professional potters and craft societies both abroad and internationally, Ruthanne will give you inspiration.
