David Cifu, MD is Chairman and the *Herman J. Flax, MD* Professor (tenured) of the Department of PM&R at the Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) School of Medicine in Richmond, Virginia, the Chief of PM&R Services of the VCU Health System, the Founding Director of the VCU-Center for Rehabilitation Sciences and Engineering, and National Director of PM&R Program Office and a member of the Cabinet-appointed member of the Senior Executive Staff for the Department of Veterans Affairs. He has been funded on 33 research grants at over \$110 million. In his more than 20 years as an academic physiatrist, he has delivered more than 460 regional, national and international lectures, published more than 190 articles and 65 abstracts, and co-authored 27 books and book chapters. He is also the Past President of the American Academy of PM&R.
