Honors Housing Contract and Application

Academic Year 2008 – 2009

All honors students are invited to apply for on-campus housing for the 2008-2009 academic year. Honors housing provides you with more than just a room in which to live. It allows you to participate in a living/learning community by interacting with other honors students and remaining an active participant of the Honors College.

Requirements

1. You must be a member of the Honors College and be in good standing (cumulative gpa = 3.5) to apply for honors housing.
2. You must agree to continue to be appropriately active in the Honors College throughout your year as a resident of honors housing. At a minimum, you must enroll in one honors course a year and either attend 3 seminars each semester or take an active leadership role in either the Idea Exchange or the Honors Student Advisory Council.
3. You must not have any disciplinary sanctions charged against you from Residence Education.

Location

Rising honors sophomores, juniors, and seniors are eligible to apply for housing in West Grace Student Housing.

Availability

Honors housing is limited. Preference is given to students who are active Honors College participants.

I understand the above conditions and submit that I am currently eligible for honors housing. In addition, I agree to remain an active participant of the Honors College while living in honors housing.
