Elaine and Amos Patterson Scholarship: The applicant must be a female 25 years or older who is enrolled in a CALL degree program with a minimum GPA of 2.0. The student must demonstrate academic intent and potential for degree success. Preference will be given to the applicant with the greatest financial need. Ralph C. and Joanne L. Cline Scholarship: The applicant must be a female 30 years or older who is enrolled in a CALL degree program as a part-time student for a minimum of six credit hours or as a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
