ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a senior graduating in May 2012
- Must be a Political Science major or McConnell Scholar
- Must be in good standing with the university
- Plans to attend graduate or professional school at the University of Louisville in the Fall of 2012 and pursue a degree in one of the following areas:
 - Music, Political Science, Education, Religion, Psychology, Public Administration, or Law School

A COMPLETE APPLICATION WILL INCLUDE:

- Cover Letter to include the following: Name, student ID, contact information, major, anticipated graduation date, and graduate school plans (including if you have already been accepted to graduate school and your expected start date).
- Applicant Resume

1 page resume detailing college experiences at the University of Louisville

• Essay

In two pages or less, describe the most influential mentor in your personal life and the characteristics of this person that you try to emulate in your own mentoring and/or leadership experiences. Include what you have accomplished as a leader and mentor, and write about how your future graduate work will further the purposes of this award.
