- 1. Faust reviewed the team's charge to identify link resolving and federated search product(s).
- 2. Examples of link resolving and federated searching capabilities exist on a microcosmic level in some of our database interfaces. The concepts were demonstrated with WilsonWeb & EBSCOHost, respectively.
- 3. Faust proposed a 7-step timeline with plans to purchase the product(s) by Tuesday, 19 July with a tentative implementation timeframe of August/September.
- 4. A list of links of major vendors and informational articles was distributed by Faust to be reviewed by team members.
- 5. Sample RFPs from Indiana University will be distributed via email to team members for review.
- 6. General discussion included concerns about implementation timing and library instruction design. Collaboration with other libraries with these technologies was suggested along with an on-site visit.
- 7. Team members were encouraged to communicate via email about specification expectations for the products. Plans were made to meet again on Monday, June 6 at 2 pm, and Wednesday, June 8 at 3 pm, anticipating the finalization of the spec. list by 10 June.
