

## Job-Specific Workers' Compensation and/ or Disability Waiver Required

To apply for an exemption from insurance requirements, the Buildings Department only accepts the Certificate of Attestation of Exemption (Form CE-200) as proof of a waiver from the New York State Workers' Compensation and/or Disability Benefits Insurance Coverage. The WC/DB-100 is no longer accepted.

New York State now requires that a Workers' Compensation and/or Disability waiver be completed <u>for each job location</u>. For jobs filed or renewed after December 1, 2008, you must obtain these waivers from the State for each initial or renewal permit. Exemptions will no longer be valid for multiple permits or on the basis of a license exemption.

The CE-200 is available on the New York State Workers' Compensation Board website at <a href="www.wcb.state.ny.us">www.wcb.state.ny.us</a>. Applicants without computer access may obtain a paper application by writing or visiting any New York State Workers' Compensation Board District Office. Applicants are responsible for keeping records of such waivers and must produce them upon request by the Department.
