## **Confirmation of Compliant Maintenance Plan**

As an applicant to become a Concessionaire, my company implements a satisfactory maintenance plan for all heavy-duty vehicles used in the Ports. - Submit documented daily vehicle inspection reports [13 CCR 1234(e)]
- Regularly and systematically inspect, maintain, and lubricate all vehicles [13 CCR 1232(a)] Document each inspection, maintenance, lubrication, and repair performed for each vehicle [13 CCR 1234(f)]

We adhere to the guidelines and schedules for maintenance established by the manufacturers of our trucks, including but not limited to:

- Regularly scheduled maintenance items as listed in each vehicle's owner's / maintenance manual (e.g., oil changes, brake inspections / changes, filter replacements, lubrications, fluid checks and top offs).
- Proper use and upkeep of the emissions control system(s) on each vehicle (including retrofit systems, if applicable)
- Strict adherence to the manufacturer's instructions for periodic cleaning of the Diesel Particulate Filter (if any) that is equipped on applicable truck

In addition to the above, we implement the following maintenance-related procedures to ensure that our trucks are properly maintained and roadworthy: (briefly describe, and append examples of forms your company uses to document regular maintenance practices).

You may use your company's normal record-keeping system, as long as your maintenance program fully covers all the components listed above and includes thorough documentation. Your company's maintenance records will be audited by the Port's Concessions Administrator.
