ABOUT YOUR APPLICATION

The Admissions Process

Applying to the St. Cloud State University (SCSU) Bachelor of Science in Nursing program is a separate process from applying to St. Cloud State University. For information on applying to the university please contact the Office of Admissions at 1-877-654-7278 or at scsu4u@stcloudstate.edu.

The application deadline for admission to the nursing program is June 1st for Spring Semester and January 5th for Fall Semester. Your application is complete only when all materials have been received by the Department of Nursing Science. It is the student's responsibility to be certain all materials are received by the due date. Late and incomplete applications are not reviewed. Emailed or faxed applications or application materials will not be accepted.

The application process consists of three steps. Step 1 involves an initial review of applications which will take place after the deadline date. After this review students will be notified if they qualify to progress to Step 2 (the Admission Assessment Exam). Following completion of Step 2 students will be notified if they are eligible to progress to Step 3 (Final Record Review). Students will be notified mid-semester whether or not they have been accepted to the Nursing major.

Eligibility

At the time of application you must meet the following requirements in order to be considered for the nursing program (eligibility does not assure admission):

- Accepted to St. Cloud State University as an undergraduate student.
- Active HuskyNet E-mail Account.
- Completed application forms and all supporting documentation
- Completed a minimum of 30 credits of required prerequisite coursework, listed on page 2, and the ability to complete all required prerequisites before start date of program.
- Achieved a minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.75 (based on a 4.0 scale).
- Achieved a minimum cumulative prerequisite GPA of 2.75 (based on a 4.0 scale).
- Minimum TOEFL Score of 220cBT, 560 paper, 83 iBT.

Access to Application File

St. Cloud State University complies with federal and state privacy laws and regulations. All application materials, once submitted, become property of the Department of Nursing Science at SCSU. You may be able to view parts of your file for advising purposes only. Only nursing faculty and staff have privileges to review application materials. We will not make copies of your application materials for you or others.

If Admitted

Additional requirements must be met if you are accepted to the nursing major. The Department of Nursing Science will facilitate the completion of these requirements. We will send more information to students upon admission to the nursing program regarding these requirements which include:

- Completion of all prerequisite courses by the start date of the program.
- Current CPR Certification at the Health Care Provider level and ability to stay current through program.
- Successfully pass a Criminal Background Check (Vulnerable Adult Act, Minnesota Statute 144.057)
- Pre-Clinical Participation Health Screening through Student Health Services on the SCSU campus (all immunization history must be provided at the time of the appointment)
- Mandatory Orientation Session

E-Mail as Official Communication to Students

HuskyNet is recognized as an official communication channel for all Students at SCSU. The HuskyNet address will be designated as applicants e-mail contact. Students are expected to receive, read, and act expeditiously upon communication distributed through HuskyNet. All notifications relative to admission/rejection will be via HuskyNet. Students must have an active HuskyNet account on the application deadline. There will be no exceptions. Students who may not be attending SCSU during the application process may keep their HuskyHNet active by sending an e-mail request to the Student Services Coordinator.

□ Complete Application Form

All information provided must be complete and correct to the best of your knowledge. A new application form must be submitted when reapplying. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered. Transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities must be attached to the application.

☐ Submit Transcripts

It is your responsibility to ensure all academic transcripts are received by the Department of Nursing Science. This includes transcripts from SCSU and all previously attended colleges/universities. Transcripts must be attached and submitted with your application. Transcripts can be official or unofficial. Submitting your transcripts for admission to SCSU is a separate process from submitting your transcripts for admission to the nursing major. The submission of a SCSU DARS Report does not meet this requirement.

☐ Letter of Reference Forms (Two)

References must be submitted directly to the Department of Nursing Science in the format provided. Students may hand deliver references provided it is in a sealed envelope with the signature of the reference across the seal. You must submit at least one reference from an academic source. The second reference can come from a professional source. Academic sources include recent college or university instructors; professional sources include employers or direct supervisors. Students who have attended a

nursing program at another institution are required to obtain a reference from the chair of the Nursing Department at that institution (can be in addition to, or part of, the 2 references).

☐ Major/Minor Application Form

Complete the major/minor application form including name, address and SCSU ID. Please use pencil to complete your information. Fill in the appropriate grades for all courses completed. Use IP (in progress) to indicate any course(s) you are currently registered for. Make sure to sign and date the form. You do not need advisor signatures at this time.

☐ Students with Transfer Credits

If you have transferred courses from another institution you must provide a Transfer Evaluation Worksheet or Degree Audit Report (DARS). This can be obtained online from your e-Services registration site at SCSU or from the Office of Records and Registration (AS 118, 320.308.2111).

□ Course Substitutions

If you are taking prerequisite courses at another institution, or taking SCSU courses other than those listed, you must provide course equivalency documentation. You can obtain this from the Webbased Course Transfer System (www.uselectmn.org) or from the appropriate SCSU department. Please check with the Student Services Coordinator before taking a course other than those listed as prerequisites.

☐ If you are new to St. Cloud State University

If you have never enrolled at St. Cloud State University as an undergraduate student, you must submit an Undergraduate Application for Admission, in addition to this application.
