Group Billing Plan



- A simplified group-invoice program for individual membership.
- Requires a minimum of 15 employees.
- Each individual within the plan must join PMI and a minimum of one Chapter and one Specific Interest Group (SIG). Dues for each individual under the plan are based on the established PMI dues and the standard fees set for the selected Components.
- The new member application fee is waived for individuals joining under the Group Billing Plan.
- Organizations can begin participating at any time throughout the year. Once the plan is initiated, individuals can join or renew at any time during the year. Each individual will receive a full year of membership.
- Renewal invoices will be sent to both the individual and the organization in a systematic procedure. Individuals, in communications with their employers, will determine whether the organization intends to pay for the renewals, or whether employees should renew individually.
- An organizational liaison must be identified to receive group renewal invoices and to serve as liaison between the organization and PMI.

To apply for the PMI Group Billing Plan, please complete and return the form on the following page and enclose one individual membership application for each <u>new</u> member along with payment. Photocopy the application as needed. Applications are not required for renewing members.
